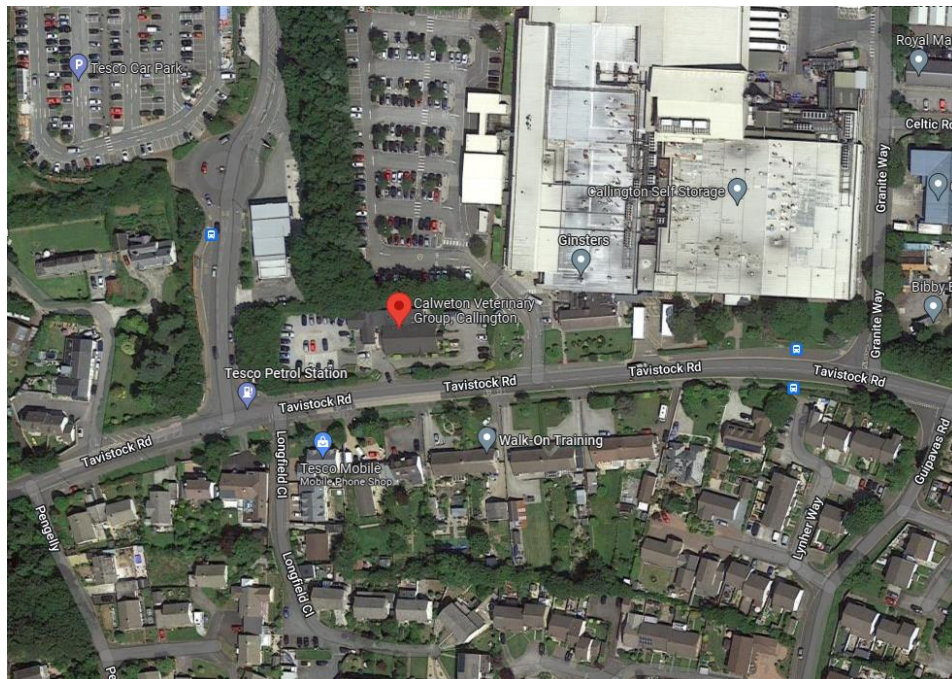

EMS Info

We ask that students arrive at 8.30am on their first day with us and come prepared with suitable protective clothing (wellies and waterproof trousers as a minimum), basic diagnostic equipment (stethoscope & thermometer), enthusiasm and a professional appearance e.g. black jeans and a polo shirt, no trainers. You will spend the day on calls with the vets and can travel to calls with the vet.

There is a Tesco nearby where you can purchase lunch, but due to the nature of farm practice, you may not return to the practice for lunch, so we advise you bring or buy lunch before the start of the working day.
